RESULTS OF THE FOUR BALLOTS ON THE CONTINUATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL ACTIONS

Between the 17 and 24 June 2013, the local SUEPO committees at the four duty stations have organised ballots to decide on the continuation of the industrial actions after 30 June.

On Monday 17 June, **the Berlin membership has voted in favour** of the action plan by a majority of **99.1%** with a turnout of **61.8%**.

From Wednesday 19 June until Friday 21 June, **the membership of The Hague has voted in favour** of the action plan by a majority of **84.3%** with a turnout of **59%**.

On Friday 21 June, **the Vienna membership has voted in favour** of the action plan by a majority of **94.2%** with a turnout of **81.3%**.

On Tuesday 24 June, **the Munich membership has voted in favour** of the action plan by a majority of **92.5%** with a turnout of **56.8%**.

Overall, the Central Action plan has been adopted by a massive majority of 90.15% and a turnout of 58.6%.
